Central Virginia Raceway Ministries (CVRM) is an interdenominational ministry supported by churches and individuals in the Central Virginia/Richmond Metropolitan area with a genuine desire to provide a friendly, caring community as we reach out to all race fans, track employees and emergency rescue workers as **ambassadors of goodwill** during motor racing events at the Richmond International Raceway.

CVRM is a partner with Motor Racing Outreach (Charlotte N.C.) in mutual endeavors that seek to bring a witness of Christ's love to race fans and the racing community during race weekends. CVRM ministry goals include:



- To minister along side of RIR Guest Services to make the experience at each racing event as positive and enjoyable as possible.
- To provide services and activities "free of charge" to all during race weekends.
- To maintain a witness of moral stability among race fans and provide a positive influence as we minister as ambassadors of goodwill.
- To provided wholesome, quality services and activities that preserve and promote an already strong "family-friendly" environment at RIR.
- To provide counseling services to assist fans in times of personal and family crisis while at the raceway. In addition, qualified chaplains will assist the emergency medical personnel as they deal with crises at the first aid/care center locations.
- To provide scheduled services of Christian worship for interested fans, track employees, and fire/rescue personnel.

**MINISTRY SERVICE OPPORTUNITIES AVAILABLE
DURING RACE WEEKENDS AT
RICHMOND INTERNATIONAL RACEWAY**

Central Virginia Raceway Ministries (CVRM) has been granted the unique opportunity to minister through RIR guest services to over 100,000 race fans during NASCAR, Indy and USAC race weekends. **Many Volunteers are needed to serve as ambassadors of goodwill** not just to provide race fans with the practical information about the raceway complex and services, but most importantly to be a witness of Christ's love by offering them a chance to sit down in our tent to enjoy a cold drink and homemade cookies while listening to a Christian musician or be entertained by a clown or juggler, to read the Christian testimony of their favorite driver or view an inspiring video, to participate in worship services, or to receive crisis counseling, leading them to ultimately know HIS transforming presence.

Volunteers are asked to work just one three or four hour shift on either Friday or Saturday during a race weekend at one of three ministry sites. Shift time are: 9 a.m.-1 p.m., 1-4 p.m., 4-7 p.m. and 7-10 p.m. The Logistics Team also needs assistance with set-up on Thursdays in the morning and afternoon and with take-down on Sunday afternoons.

Agenda items for this meeting include briefing by a RIR guest services official, discussion of volunteer responsibilities, finalization of the plans for the week-end activities, and a chance to ask questions and sign up for a shift time. Volunteers can also purchase a CVRM Tee Shirt or Ball Cap to wear during their shift.
